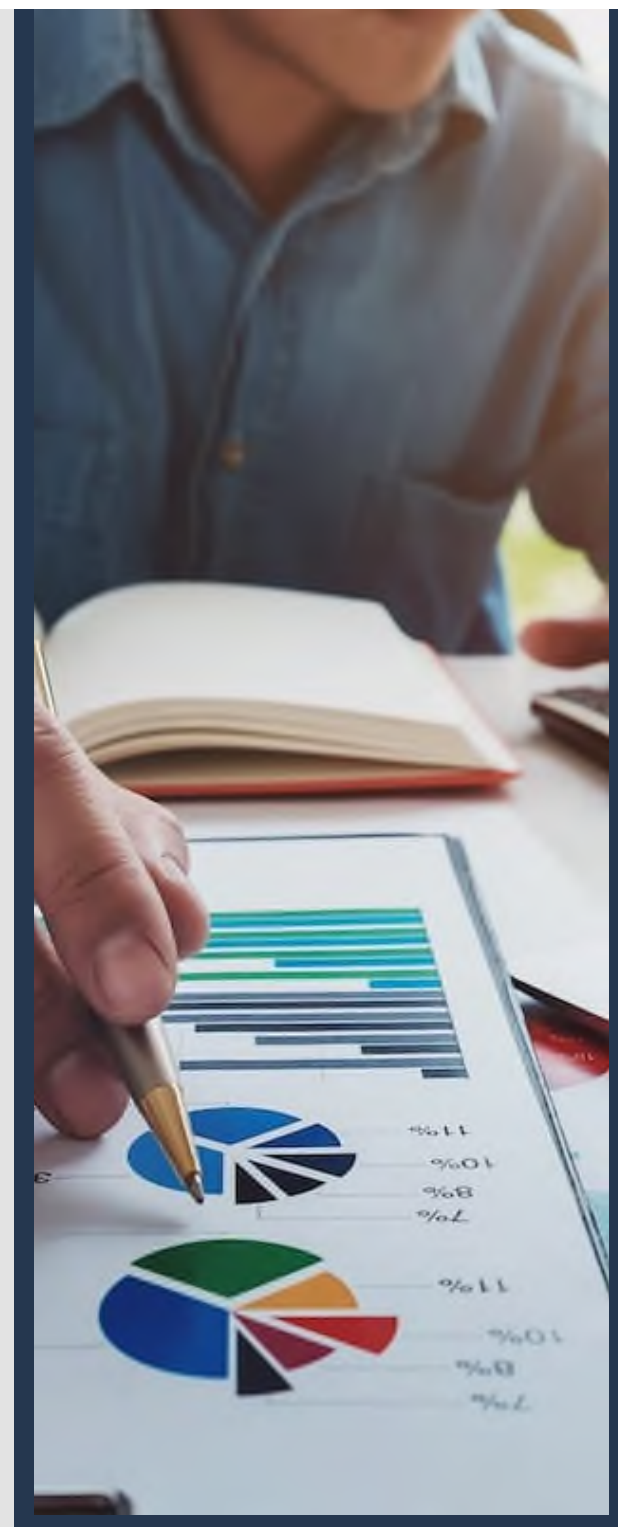
WHO WOULD BENEFIT ?
